

Thank you for your interest in working at *Halloween Nights at Eastern State Penitentiary!* Please read and fill out this application very carefully and bring it with you to your **education interview**! We will take your photo at the interview, so there is no need to bring a headshot.

Here is some background information about Eastern State Penitentiary and our Halloween event. It's important that our employees understand the mission behind our operation!

Eastern State Penitentiary

When Eastern State Penitentiary opened in 1829, it was the world's first true *penitentiary* and eventually became a model for 300 prisons worldwide. The original seven cellblocks spread like the spokes of a wheel and had running water and central heat before the White House. Its vaulted, sky-lit cells held many of America's most notorious lawbreakers, including Al Capone. The penitentiary was closed in 1971 and was abandoned. Today, the prison stands in ruin.

Daytime prison tours began in 1994 and a private non-profit organization, Eastern State Penitentiary Historic Site Inc. was formed to operate the site and interpret the legacy of American criminal justice reform, from the nation's founding through to the present day, within the long-abandoned cellblocks of the nation's most historic prison. The penitentiary is open for daytime prison tours seven days a week, year-round.

Halloween Nights

Halloween Nights is our annual Halloween-themed fundraiser event providing safe, fun, high quality entertainment that raises funds used to help fulfill the mission of ESPHS, Inc. All proceeds from the event are used to support the preservation and interpretation of this National Historic Landmark.

Interview Protocol

Interviews take place in groups of 5 to 6 people. It's important that you have read the specific education position descriptions on our website before your interview.

Please note that if you are offered conditional employment at *Halloween Nights*, you must successfully complete both a I-9, a W-4 and be enrolled into our payroll system Paycom before the first night of training on Wednesday, September 7th, 2022. If you are conditionally selected, you will have to fill out a Criminal Background Check. You cannot be hired until you successfully complete all necessary paperwork.

Educator Engagement Interview Activity

Eastern State Penitentiary Educators work hard to develop guided tours with memorable themes, to be clear, concise and audible in delivery, and to come across as warm and approachable. This exercise is an opportunity for you to demonstrate these core educator characteristics.

Prepare a <u>two- to four-minute</u> true story that has a clear beginning, middle, and end. This short talk can be based on a personal experience, historic or current events. Please be sure you are comfortable discussing the topic you choose. Your story does not need to be related to incarceration or Eastern State Penitentiary. Notes are not permitted. The audience for the presentation will include the interview team and other interviewees in your group.

As you prepare, consider:

- What can the audience learn from the story?
 - O What makes your story relevant?
 - o Think broadly!
 - O What should we walk away thinking about?
- How can you involve the audience?
 - o Engaging questions?
 - o Discussion?
 - o Is there something we can do together?

This is a chance to practice using themes and contexts, to be engaging and friendly, and let your personality shine through. Don't worry about accuracy!
