Photography Policies

- No smoking is permitted anywhere within the penitentiary.
- Please do not touch or move any objects or artifacts.
- Respect for the people who lived and worked at the penitentiary must be exercised at all times. Therefore, the use of models, costuming (i.e. prison uniforms) or props (i.e. handcuffs, straightjackets), nudity, semi-nudity, or sexually provocative or sexually explicit images or any content in conflict with the mission of Eastern State Penitentiary Historic Site filmed/photographed at the penitentiary is prohibited.
- Eastern State Penitentiary Historic Site requires the location credit “Eastern State Penitentiary, Philadelphia, PA” in all uses of penitentiary photos in print, on the web, in broadcast, and in any other public medium.
- Eastern State Penitentiary assumes no responsibility for loss, theft, or damage to equipment.
- The use of drones on site is prohibited.

Additionally, when Eastern State opens for tours to the public at 10:00 am...

- Please refrain from loud conversations and avoid gathering along the audio tour route.
- Due to COVID-19 restrictions, all visitors must follow a one-way path from audio stops 1-10. During public hours, you will not be permitted to leave this linear path when taking photos in this area.
- No equipment (tripods, monopods, etc.) is permitted during public hours at this time.
- Eastern State does not allow third parties to conduct fee-based photography workshops or classes on site during public hours. Any persons conducting unauthorized events will be asked to leave the site without a refund.
